HODDER CARTWAY SPECIAL MTG.—Aug. 24, 2011

Members present: Rod Schloesser, Dave Schaumburg, Gene Williams, Connie Glass, Lloyd Thyen and Glen Mechelke.

Also present were Jerry Lamon of the Cass County Land Dept. and Terry Hodder, agent of the petitioner Dale Hodder.

Board members met to determine if Hodder already had access to the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of sec. 3 Township 139 Range 26 and examine possible cart way routes if he did not have access.

Hodder stated that he had authorization to remove beaver dams on his property that would lower the water level to a point where he would be able to establish access over the remaining low land on the his property, to the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Sec. 3 Township 139 Range 26.

He also stated that he was told he could establish access over the remaining low land if he replaced the resulting damages to the wetland with additional purchased wetlands.

He was concerned that establishing access in this manner would do considerable damage to Abe Lake, located in the Acorn Acres development, and all other property abutting Abe Lake, as the lake level would be considerably reduced.
